

I-601A Application Checklist

We have noticed that applicants frequently fail to complete certain items on their application. Please remember to:

- Answer **Part 1, Questions 27, 28.a., 28.b., and 29.a.**;
- Provide the USCIS Receipt Number for your approved Form I-130, Form I-140, or I-360 in **Part 3, Question 3.a.**;
- Provide the Consular Case Number (NVC Case Number) in **Part 3, Question 3.b.**; and
- Sign and date the application in **Part 6, Questions 6.a and 6.b.**

We may return your application if you do not complete these items.

Form I-601A Document Checklist

Please send the following items with your Form I-601A application:

- U.S. Department of State (DOS) Immigrant Visa Processing Fee Receipt
 - The Immigrant Visa Application Fee varies depending on your immigrant category.
 - You can print the receipt from the Department of State website after you make the payment. Make sure the National Visa Center (NVC) Case Number is clearly visible.
- A copy of Form I-797 indicating approval of the underlying petition (Form I-130, Form I-140, or Form I-360), if available
- Application fee
- Proof of relationship to all qualifying relatives, if applicable
- Proof of citizenship or lawful permanent resident status of qualifying relative(s), if applicable
- Proof of extreme hardship (this is always required)
- All related court dispositions if you answered “YES” for **Questions 34 or 35**
- A statement from the qualifying relative certifying under penalty of perjury that the qualifying relative would separate (remain in the U.S.) or relocate (move abroad with applicant) if the applicant is denied admission.

We may return your application if you do not include these documents along with your application.
